

KVCC App Overview

Our students are accessing more through their phones than ever before. The KVCC App allows our students to gain access to important student information, communicate with students, staff, and faculty, and remain connected to the college.

The KVCC App is a product of Ooh La La and Dub Labs. It was not created here on campus. KVCC does control the look of the app and how it is used.

Students, faculty, and staff download the app from Google Play or the App Store. There is no cost for the app. Everyone logs in with the full email address and the same password as the single sign on password used for all other KVCC technologies. By using the full email address the app can associate the person with KVCC.

The home page of the app is built to provide student information. There are tiles for student life and campus information. These tiles are changed out to be most pertinent to the time of year. For example, when it is time to register students will see a registration tile appear.

The most used portion of the app to date, is the Campus Wall. This is very similar to other social media options. Students, faculty, and staff may write on the wall, reply to other's posts, and post pictures. The wall is broken into categories such as "ride share" and "buy and sell". All categories show on the "student feed". This is a great way for students to support each other and remain connected to the college. Instant messaging is built into the app.

Another great feature of the KVCC App, is the events feature. This is a way to inform students of what is happening on campus and for students to let others know what is happening with clubs on campus. With the help of a QR code generated through the App, attendance at events may be tracked and attendees can provide feedback.
